

# Bryan Patrick Woodford's

## *Last Will & Testament*

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I, BRYAN PATRICK WOODFORD, of Abington, Massachusetts, make this as my first will, with no other wills or codicils previously made by me.

### **ARTICLE 1: APPOINTMENT OF PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE**

I appoint my lovely and beautiful wife, BROOKE LEE WOODFORD, of Abington, Massachusetts as my Personal Representative, to administer this Will, and request that she be allowed to serve without furnishing surety or sureties upon her official bond. If she is unwilling or unable to serve, I then appoint my favorite sister KRISTIN WOODFORD to serve as my Personal Representative and, request that she be allowed to serve without furnishing surety or sureties upon her official bond.

### **ARTICLE 2: PAYMENT OF JUST DEBTS**

I direct my Personal Representative to pay all the expenses of my last illness; estate administration expenses; legally enforceable creditor claims; Federal estate taxes; and funeral expenses, from my estate.

### **ARTICLE 3: GIFT OF MY ENTIRE ESTATE**

I give all of my estate to my wife, BROOKE LEE WOODFORD, but shall she not survive me, then I give it all to the Trustee(s) of THE BROOKE & BRYAN WOODFORD IRREVOCABLE TRUST.

**ARTICLE 4: RECOMMENDATION OF GUARDIAN FOR MY MINOR CHILDREN**

Shall my wife predecease me, I nominate and request that my sister, KRISTIN WOODFORD, of Abington, MA and my brother in-law CONNOR FRASER, of Abington, MA, act as the co-guardians of all of my children, because I know they will love take and care for them as Brooke and I did, and also request that all the children live together with Kristin, and if she is unwilling or unable to take them all then I wish for them all to live with Connor.

**ARTICLE 5: POWERS OF PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE**

In addition to all of the statutory powers granted to my Personal Representative under the Uniform Statutory Will Act, Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 191B § 13 (b), my Personal Representative may do any and all acts and things, and execute any and all such written instruments with respect to such property as if the absolute owner thereof, without ever having to seek authority from any court to do so, unless required by law.

**ARTICLE 6: LIABILITY OF PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE**

No Personal Representative or successor Personal Representative shall be liable for any error or judgment or for any act or default of any co-fiduciary, but shall be liable for his or her willful breach of duty.

**ARTICLE 07: OMISSIONS**

Except to the extent to which I have included them in the provisions of this will, I have intentionally, and not a result of any accident or mistake, omitted in this will to provide for any heir, individual, or entity.

**ARTICLE 08: SELF PROVING AFFIDAVIT**

I, the undersigned Testator, being over the age of 18 and of sound mind, sign this as my will in the presence of each of said witnesses, and that I sign it willingly and as my free and voluntary act for the purposes herein expressed.
